

YWAM's Discipleship Training School

The Discipleship Training School is a six-month Christian training program offered all over the world with the emphasis on knowing God and making Him known. The DTS is offered as the foundation of Youth With A Mission's international ministry and is a requirement for attending further schools within YWAM's University of the Nations program, or becoming a full-time staff member. This school is designed to help you grow in your relationship with God and prepare you for an active part in missions.

What does the school involve?

The DTS consists of two phases, the "lecture" phase and the "outreach" phase. The first 12-week phase allows you to receive teachings from Christian leaders, pastors, and teachers from around the world, in basic areas such as: knowing God, how to hear His voice, repentance and forgiveness, worship, understanding the Bible and how to apply it to your life, intercession, and the Father heart of God. You will live together in a community setting with the other students and share times of teaching, worship, prayer, fellowship in small groups, work duties and ministry.

The second phase is a 12-week evangelistic outreach dedicated to making God known by putting into practice what you learned in the classroom. This outreach offers opportunities to serve outside Albania, as well as working in small teams in cities and villages throughout Albania. Students will get to be involved in local ministries through evangelism, practical work, teaching and praying.
